Luke 18: 1 - 8

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

Prayer is a way we stay in touch with God in our daily life. When you speak to God, what do you pray for?

Children:

What is something you could pray to God for?

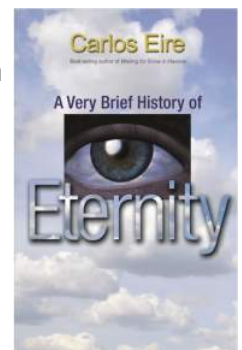

Grandparents Ministry

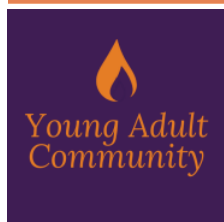

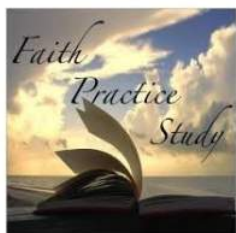

Care for Creation

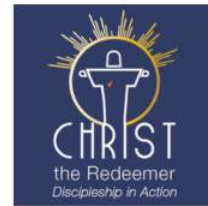


Members of our Care for Creation team attended a blessing of a new Trex bench on Monday, September 29 at the Sacred Heart Residence, a community for

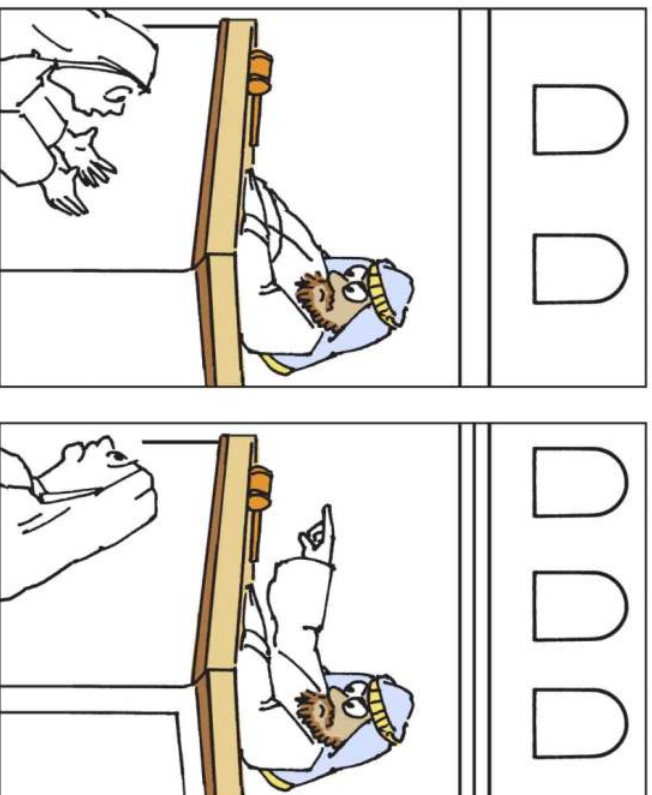
