The Word

Reading for October 26, 2025

Luke 18: 9 - 14

Adults:

Jesus says that the Pharisee's belief that he is better than the tax collector interferes in his relationship with God. How can someone be proud of themselves without being prideful?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

Can you name something that a friend or family member does better than you that you admire?

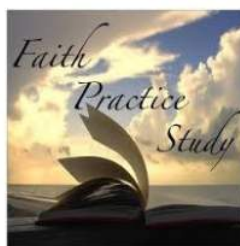
Prayer Shawl Ministry

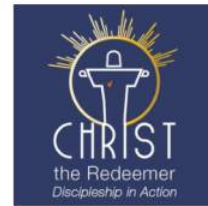

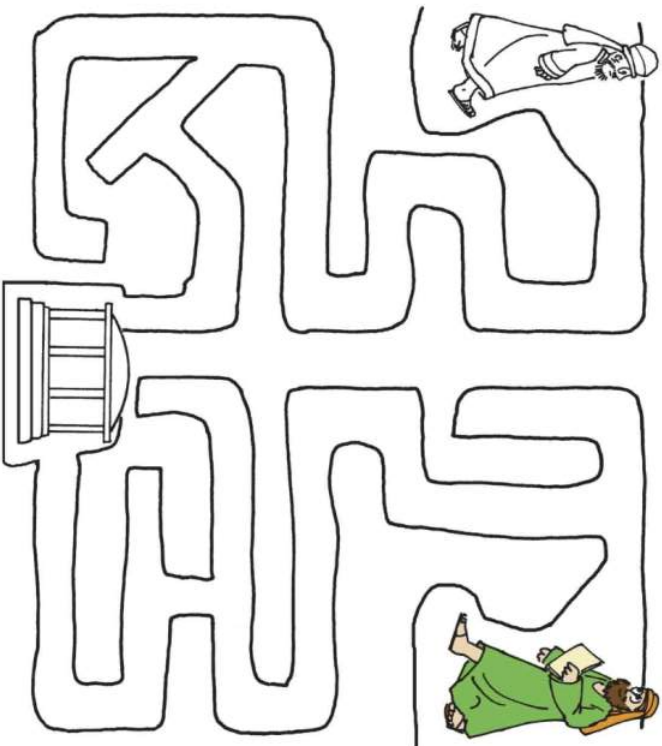
