Reading for November 9, 2025

1 Corinthians 3:9c-11, 16-17

Adults:

How do you build your life on the foundation that God has laid for you?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

This scripture speaks of the fact that the Spirit of God dwells in each of us. How can you show respect for yourself as a temple of that spirit?

Children:

What kind and loving things can you do to show how God's spirit is in you?

In 1 Corinthians 3:9–11, 16–17, St. Paul reminds us, “For we are God’s co-workers; you are God’s field, God’s building... No one can lay any foundation

other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ... Do you not know that you are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in you?”

As parents in today’s world, these words offer both comfort and challenge. We are called to be co-builders with God, laying down strong spiritual foundations in our children’s lives even as the world pulls them in countless directions. The noise of social media, the pressure to achieve, and the distractions of a busy modern life can easily shake that foundation. But Paul reminds us that Christ is the cornerstone. Parenting today is not easy, but we are never building alone. God works through our imperfections, guiding each small act of love into something eternal. With Christ as our foundation, our families can stand firm through every storm.

Prayer for Persecuted Christians in Nigeria



Pope Leo XIV, recently addressed the ongoing violence against Christian communities in Nigeria, particularly highlighting a tragic massacre that occurred in Benue State on June 13-14. Between 100 and 200 people were killed in this attack, with the majority being internally displaced persons who had sought refuge at a local Catholic mission.

This tragedy is part of a larger pattern of religious persecution that continues to afflict Christian communities throughout Nigeria and other parts of the world. Our brothers and sisters in Christ face daily threats simply for practicing their faith.

Let us unite our prayers with those of Pope Leo XIV for an end to this violence, for the protection of all persecuted Christians, and for true peace and reconciliation in Nigeria.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, we lift up our persecuted brothers and sisters in Nigeria and throughout the world. Grant them strength, protection, and consolation in their suffering. Transform the hearts of those who perpetrate violence, and guide all people toward justice, peace, and respect for human dignity. May the sacrifice of those who have died for their faith bear fruit in a lasting peace. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

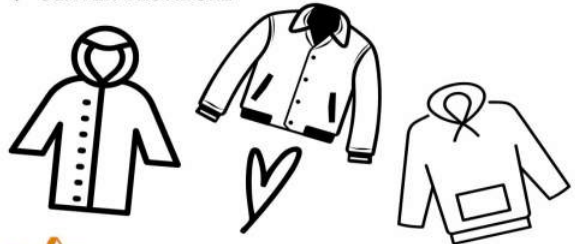

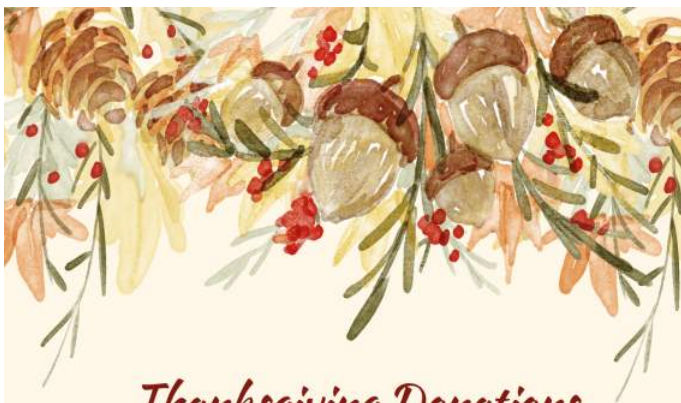

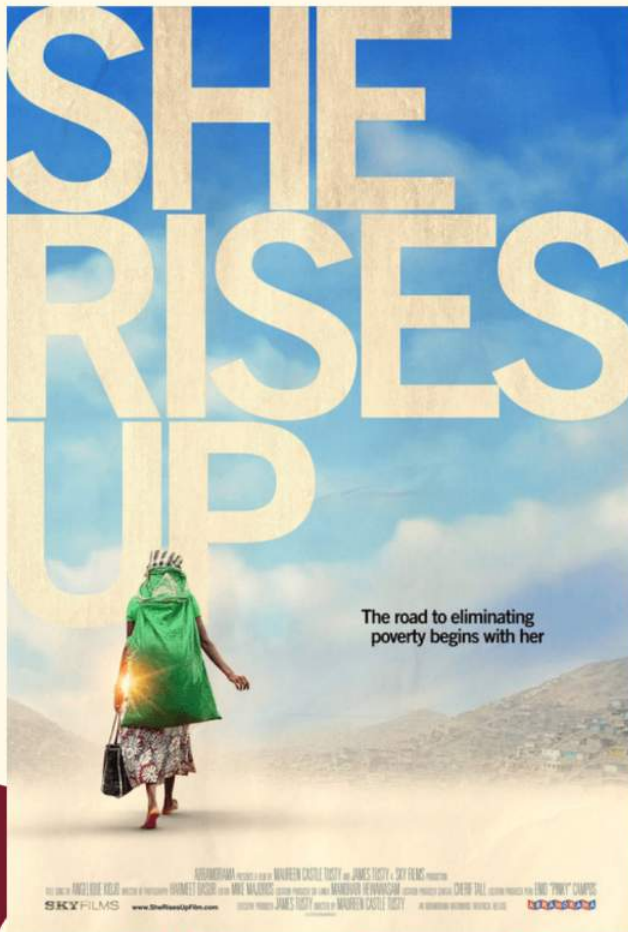

Christmas Assistance Programs for Families in Need

All requests are confidential!

Our parish coordinates several programs to assist families in need during this Advent and Christmas season:

- The parish Elementary Faith Formation program coordinates a toy drive benefiting **Sacred Heart Church in Camden's Annual Christmas Toy Store**. This program invites qualified families to shop for Christmas presents at greatly reduced prices for children 12 years and under. Our drive will run from **November 17 – December 5**. All toy donations must be new and unwrapped. Children can bring the donations with them to EFF class or parishioners can drop them off in the Parish Center vestibule.
- Suggested gift donations over \$15 include: sports equipment (footballs, basketballs, Nerf balls/no blasters), dolls (African American and Hispanic), doll accessories (houses, strollers, etc.), Lego sets, games (Connect 4, Operation, Trouble, Memory, Scrabble Jr, etc.), Playskool and Fisher Price toys, and Minecraft.
- Please do NOT donate the following items: stuffed animals, puzzles, coloring books, crayons, Play-Doh, clay, any sports items for soccer, hockey, and tennis, and games such as CandyLand, Chutes & Ladders, and Yahtzee.
- **The Giving Tree** provides gifts to families served by Guadalupe Family Services in Camden. The tree will stand in the Gathering Space Alcove during Advent beginning the evening of Saturday, November 29. If you would like to participate, please take a tag, purchase the requested item, and return the gift to the tree **by Monday, December 15**. Gifts should be returned unwrapped with the tag attached to it, though a gift bag or wrapping paper with tape is much appreciated.



- **The "Adopt-a-Family" Christmas gift program** invites parishioners to sponsor Christmas gifts for children of local families in need. Last year we were able to help close to 60 families with physical gifts and gift cards. There are several ways to be a part of the "Adopt-a-Family" program: you may choose to buy physical gifts for a specific family, donate gift cards for a specific family so the parents can shop for their children, or you can donate gift cards/checks to a general program fund for parish staff to disburse among our program recipients. The price of each meal's ingredients is 22 cents - Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) is a Minnesota-based Christian non-profit 501 (c) (3) organization that is dedicated to getting nutrition to starving and malnourished children all over the world.

First brought to Haddonfield by First Presbyterian Church, MobilePack events have been hosted by Haddonfield Council of Churches since 2016. FMSC brings all ingredients and supplies to us, and the meals are packed assembly-line style by small groups, now in the National Guard Armory in Cherry Hill. Participants include families, civic organizations, clubs, schools, churches and synagogues, and businesses.

FMSC provides a deeply meaningful service opportunity. Participants are able to work together for a finite period of time and with a specific, high-value outcome. At the end of every volunteer session the group knows exactly how many meals were produced to eliminate hunger in the world. In a uniquely experiential and fun way, the FMSC volunteer experience engages hearts, hands, and minds and fulfills the need of the giver to give.

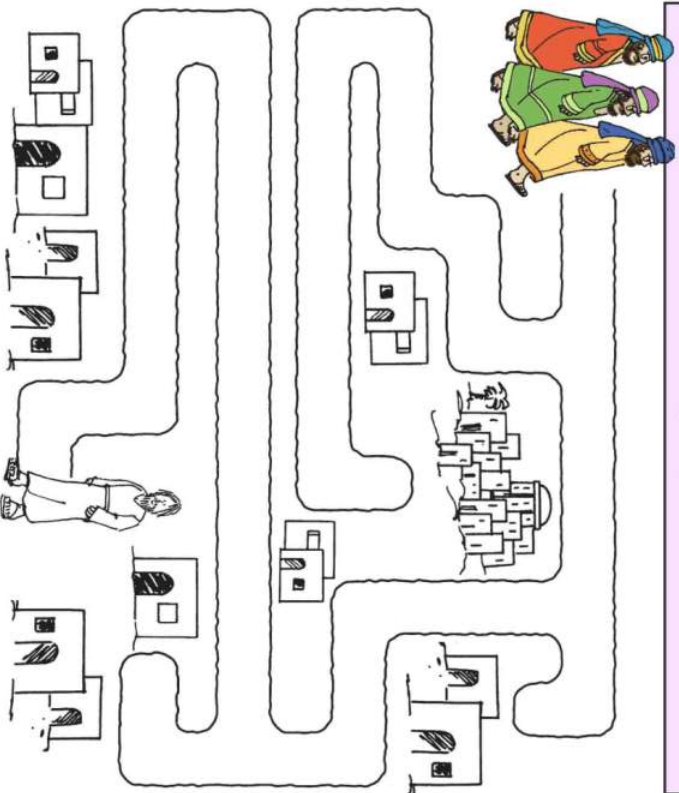

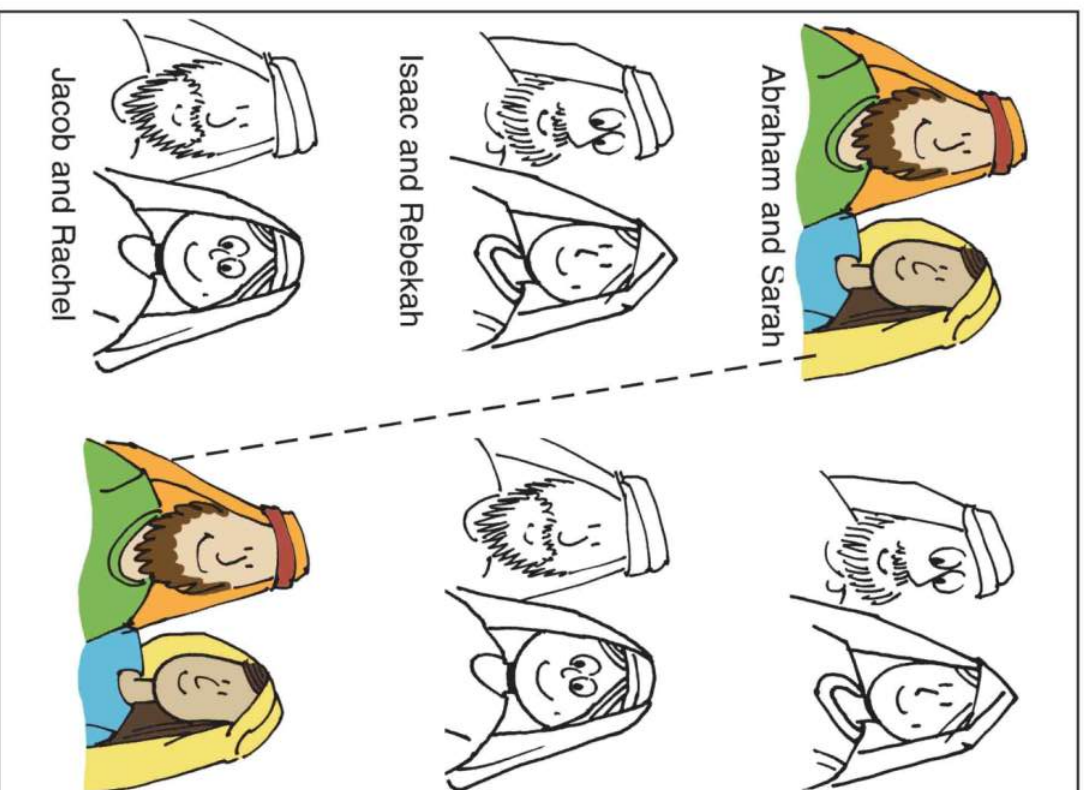
