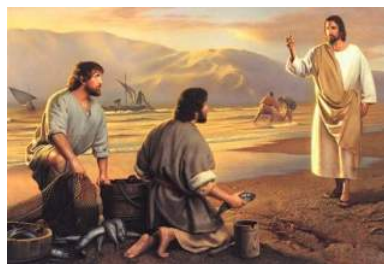

Come and See



In Luke 23:35–43, the scene at the cross reveals a profound model of discipleship through the figure often called the “good thief” or repentant criminal.

While the crowds, leaders, and soldiers mock Jesus, the repentant criminal chooses a different path: he recognizes Jesus’ innocence, acknowledges his own sin, and defends Jesus in the face of public ridicule. This courageous act mirrors the heart of discipleship—following Jesus even when it is difficult, unpopular, or costly. His willingness to stand with Christ in suffering shows that true discipleship involves humility, self-examination, and moral courage.

The passage also highlights a deepened understanding of who Jesus is. The repentant criminal expresses faith not in a triumphant, earthly messiah, but in the crucified Christ, saying, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” This demonstrates a disciple’s willingness to trust Jesus beyond appearances, circumstances, or worldly expectations. Genuine discipleship sees God’s presence even in moments of suffering and believes that Jesus’ kingship extends beyond earthly power. Through his simple yet profound declaration, the criminal becomes a witness to the truth of Jesus’ identity.

Finally, this scene reveals an intimate model of relationship with God. Jesus responds, “Today you will be with me in paradise,” showing that God’s mercy is immediate, personal, and transformative. The relationship between Jesus and the repentant criminal shows that closeness to God is not earned by status or achievements but opens to anyone with faith and repentance. In this moment, the Gospel emphasizes that a relationship with God is built on trust, grace, and the personal call of Jesus. It reminds disciples that even in our brokenness, God invites us into communion and offers the promise of eternal life.

Reading for November 23, 2025

Luke 23: 35-43

Adults:

How have you learned to rely on God's wisdom in difficult situations?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

How can you show that you honor Jesus as King of your life?

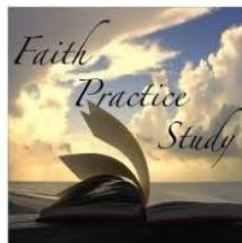

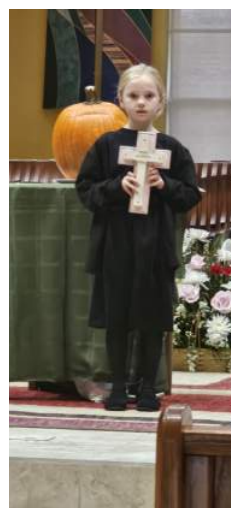

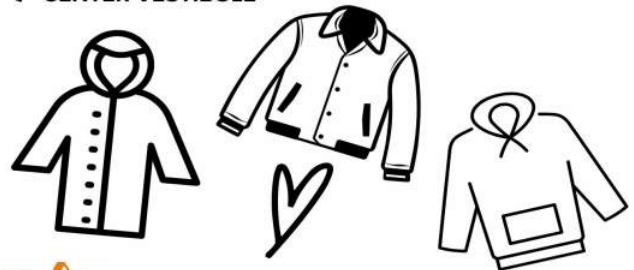

Christmas Assistance Programs for Families in Need



If you are in need of assistance for providing Christmas gifts for your children (ages 17 and under) this year, please contact the Parish Office.

All requests are confidential!

Our parish coordinates several programs to assist families in need during this Advent and Christmas season:

- The parish Elementary Faith Formation program coordinates a toy drive benefiting **Sacred Heart Church in Camden's Annual Christmas Toy Store**. This program invites qualified families to shop for Christmas presents at greatly reduced prices for children 12 years and under. Our drive will run from **November 17 – December 5**. All toy donations must be new and unwrapped. Children can bring the donations with them to EFF class or parishioners can drop them off in the Parish Center vestibule.
- Suggested gift donations over \$15 include: sports equipment (footballs, basketballs, Nerf balls/no blasters), dolls (African American and Hispanic), doll accessories (houses, strollers, etc.), Lego sets, games (Connect 4, Operation, Trouble, Memory, Scrabble Jr, etc.), Playskool and Fisher Price toys, and Minecraft.
- Please do NOT donate the following items: stuffed animals, puzzles, coloring books, crayons, Play-Doh, clay, any sports items for soccer, hockey, and tennis, and games such as CandyLand, Chutes & Ladders, and Yahtzee.
- **The Giving Tree** provides gifts to families served by Guadalupe Family Services in Camden. The tree will stand in the Gathering Space Alcove during Advent beginning the evening of Saturday, November 29. If you would like to participate, please take a tag, purchase the requested item, and return the gift to the tree **by Monday, December 15**. Gifts should be returned unwrapped with the tag attached to it, though a gift bag or wrapping paper with tape is much appreciated.



- **The "Adopt-a-Family" Christmas gift program** invites parishioners to sponsor Christmas gifts for children of local families in need. Last year we were able to help close to 60 families with physical gifts and gift cards. There are several ways to be a part of the "Adopt-a-Family" program: you may choose to buy physical gifts for a specific family, donate gift cards for a specific family so the parents can shop for their children, or you can donate gift cards/checks to a general program fund for parish staff to disburse among our program recipients. 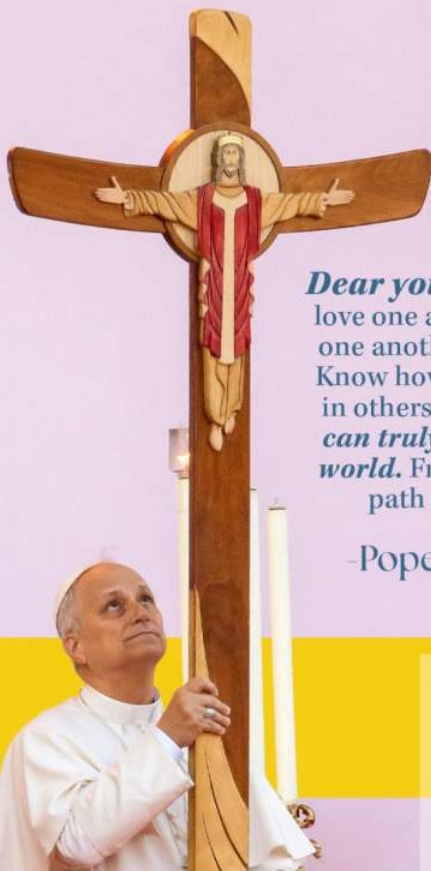

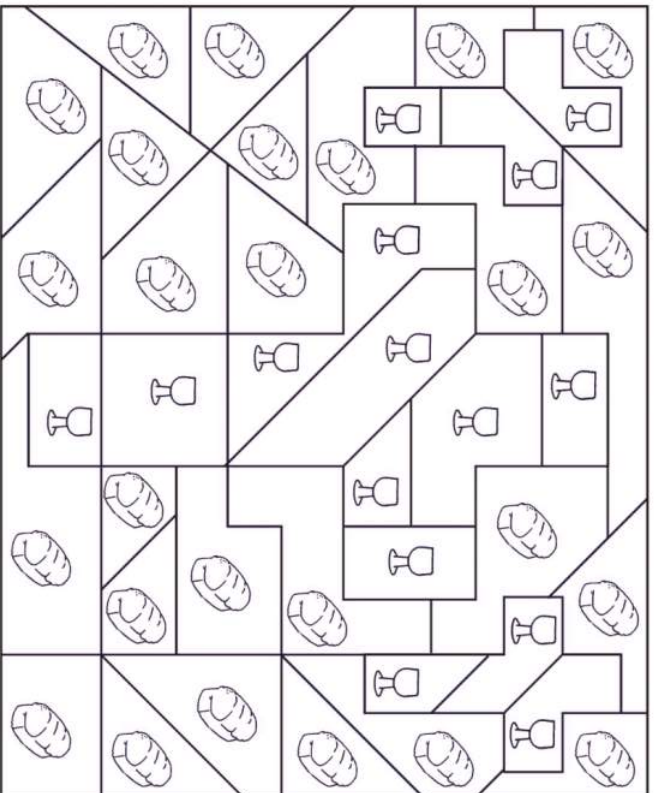
