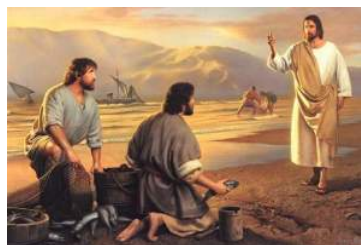

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

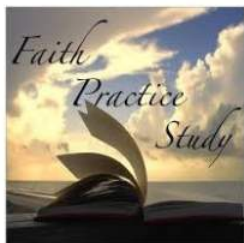
