

Catholic Charities is setting up two distribution sites in the diocese:

St. Gianna (old St. Bernadette) in Northfield on New Road

Distribution will take place between the hours of 12 - 5. Volunteers will be needed beginning at 10, possibly earlier depending on FEMA delivery schedule.

Notre Dame de Mer in Wildwood (St. Anne parking lot site 3000 Atlantic Ave)

Distribution will take place between the hours of 10 - 3. Volunteers are needed beginning at 9

Distribution Sites will open beginning Saturday, Nov. 3rd and be open daily (7 days a week) until the need subsides

Volunteer Opportunities

1. Staffing Distribution site (client intakes, packing bags, unloading pallets, breaking down pallets, crowd control, traffic control, set up, clean up, donations management, security)
2. Delivering goods to smaller distribution sites such as parishes or community centers (loading up own vehicle and going to designated spots)
3. Media work: facebook, website, press releases, photos - work with CC staff to help make sure the important stories are being told and current needs are being met
4. Donations management (offsite) – Catholic Charities will begin collecting (10AM-3PM) specific in kind donations to bring down to the distribution sites as well as to the Family Services Centers in Camden, Gloucester, Cumberland and Salem on as needed basis. Volunteers can help with managing the collection, sorting and driving to appropriate sites. This collection point is at 1845 Haddon Ave, in Camden near Lourdes Hospital.
