Prepare frozen meals at home for seniors	St. Bart's Serves Seniors	St. Bart's has an outreach program providing nutritious meals to seniors in Camden. The parish will provide dishes to use which have compartments as well as meal suggestions. These meals will be made at home, frozen at home (preferably) and returned. After you register, Julie will contact you to schedule a time to pick up supplies and to drop off the meals.
Make sandwiches	Sandwiches benefit Cathedral Kitchen, Last Stop, Joseph's House, and St. Bart's	Make at home and drop off at the Parish Center between 9-11 am on October 19. Sandwiches can be made of beef bologna or turkey breast and American cheese. Please use one slice of cheese and two slices of meat on either white or wheat bread. After assembling the sandwich, place it in a Ziplock bag and seal it (we avoid using the flap-type sandwich bags since they are not as hygienic for food distribution). You can place the completed sandwiches in the bread sleeve and seal it.
